

Privacy Policy for Airbus DS SLC Partner Portal

Introduction:

Your privacy is important to us and we want you to feel comfortable using our Partner Portal.

Airbus SAS and its affiliates, especially Airbus DS SLC, is committed to protecting the rights of individuals in line with the **General Data Protection Regulation (reference EU2016/679)** of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of Personal Data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter referred as : ‘GDPR’) as well as each applicable national Personal Data protection laws and regulations (collectively referred as “Data Protection Laws and Regulations”).

3. What is the purpose of processing Personal Data?

The purposes of processing Personal Data are:

- *Customer service* : We use your Personal Data for customer service purposes, including providing services to you, for technical support or other similar purposes and to establish and maintain customer accounts.
- *Communication* : We use your Personal Data to communicate with you, including responding to requests for assistance.
- *Contractual obligations*: We use your Personal Data to fulfill our contractual and other promises and obligations.
- *Commercial relationship* : We use your Personal Data to take care of the partner relationship.
- *Legal compliance* : We use your Personal Data to comply with applicable legal obligations, including responding to an authority or court order or discovery request.

4. What is the basis for processing of your Personal Data?

We process your Personal Data as a result of your consent and in accordance with the provisions set out in the GDPR and the relevant applicable Data Protection Laws and Regulations. When you have consented to the processing of your Personal Data by us for certain services through the Website, you can withdraw consent at any time by following the instructions provided in the application process or by contacting us (dataprotection@airbus.com). For further information on the right of withdrawal, please see below Section 9 “*What are your rights as a Data Subject*”.

5. What Personal Data do we process?

We process the following Personal Data of our partners or other Data Subjects in connection with the Partner Portal register:

- ***basic information of the Data Subject*** such as first name*, last name*, gender*, , username and/or other identifier, password and communication language;
- ***contact information of the Data Subject*** such as email address*, mobile phone and land line phone number, fax number, distribution country*;
- ***information of company’s contact persons*** such as, names and contact details of the contact persons;
- ***information regarding the partnership and the contract*** such as current contracts, business and marketing plans and correspondence;
- ***other possible information gathered with Data Subject’s consent;***

Providing Personal Data marked with an asterisk is a requirement for our contractual relationship. Without the necessary information we are not able to grant the access to the Partner Portal.

6. From where do we receive data?

We receive information primarily from the following sources: yourself and your Company’s contact person.

For the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, Personal Data may also be collected and updated from publicly available sources and based on information received from the authorities or other third parties within the limits of the applicable laws and regulations. Such updating of data is performed manually or by automated means.

7. To whom do we disclose data, and do we transfer data outside the EU or the EEA?

We disclose data to the following parties:

- Milleniumprod SARL (the portal service provider);
- Authorised persons working for or on behalf of Airbus DS SLC;

- Airbus Group SE and affiliates of Airbus, on a need-to-know basis for the purposes as outlined in this Privacy Policy;
- Other authorised third parties in connection with a reorganisation or sale of Airbus businesses and/or assets;

Personal Data is not transferred outside the EU/EEA.

8. How do we protect the Personal Data and how long do we store them?

Data are collected into databases that are protected by firewalls, passwords and other technical measures. The databases and their backup copies are in locked premises and can be accessed only by certain pre-designated persons.

We process and store your Personal Data as long as it is required to meet our contractual and statutory obligations. If your Personal Data is no longer required for the performance of the contractual or statutory obligations, these will be erased on a regular basis unless further processing is necessary, for instance, for preserving particular evidence under the applicable Data Protection Laws and Regulations, or in the context of legal statutes of limitation.

9. What are your rights as a Data Subject?

You have the right to inspect the Personal Data stored in the register concerning yourself and the right to demand rectification or erasure of the data. If you have access to your data, you may edit the data yourself. Insofar as the processing is based on consent, you also have the right to withdraw or change your consent. Withdrawing your consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing before the withdrawal of the consent.

You have the right to object or to demand restriction of the processing of your data and to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.

On grounds relating to your particular situation you also have the right to object other processing activities when the legal basis of processing is legitimate interest. In connection with your request, you shall identify the specific situation, based on which you object to the processing. We can refuse the request of objection only on legal grounds.

You have the right to data portability : Under some circumstances provided by law, you have the right to receive the Personal Data concerning you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and/or transmit those Personal Data to another data controller.
